Session focus: With the advancement of regional integration, various cooperation mechanisms have been initiated in Asia Pacific region, including China-ASEAN FTA, GMS, Nanning-Singapore Economic Corridor, “Two Corridors and One Ring” Cooperation between China and Vietnam as well as the ongoing TPP and RCEP negotiations. At the same time, governance mechanisms at different levels have been established in the region, including China-ASEAN Committee on Connectivity Cooperation, Committee on Economic and Trade Cooperation, China-ASEAN Business Council (CABC), China-ASEAN Ministerial Meeting, etc. The session will review the present mechanisms in the region, and discuss how the Pan-beibu Gulf Region better involve the regional cooperation, and how different mechanisms complement each other.

Chinese Speakers:

Li Luoli

Vice President, China Society of Economic Reform

Prof. Li is also professor and PhD tutor at Nankai University, and Vice Chairman of China Development Institute (CDI). Prior to joining CDI, he was the Vice Secretary General of Shenzhen Communist Party Committee and also acted as Director of Shenzhen Government's Reception Office when Chinese late paramount leader Deng Xiaoping toured the southern China. Li has been engaged in research and studies on economics theory, Hong Kong and Shenzhen economy and China's reform & opening-up, with many books and papers published.



Fan Gang

President, China Development Institute / Beijing National Economy Research Institute

Prof. Fan is a well-respected expert in the macroeconomics of long-term development, international trade and currency, and China's regional integration within Asia. He is most renowned for addressing such topics as China's financial risk and financial systems reform, foreign exchange regimes and revaluation, China's economic reform, and globalization. Prof. Fan holds Ph.D. in economics, Chinese Academy of Social Sciences (CASS).



Han Feng

Vice President, National Institute of International Strategy, Chinese Academy of Social Sciences

Dr. Han graduated from the Department of International Politics, Peking University. He has been working in CASS since 1984. His research area is the current international relations in the Asia-Pacific region, especially relations among the ASEAN nations and with outside powers and the regional security. He used to be a Visiting Scholar, both in University of Tasmania, Australia and in the Conflict Management Program, Uppsala University, Sweden.



Fan Zuojun

Executive Vice President, China-ASEAN Research Institute

Prof. Fan is the doctor of economics and post doctor of finance. He is also the Director of Center for Fiscal and Finance Studies of Guangxi University. He is one of the questionnaire survey experts of the Monetary Policy Committee of China's State Council. The research interests of Prof. Fan include China-ASEAN economic integration, economic development and regional planning of Pan-beibu Gulf Rim, industrial restructure and upgrading, etc.



Liu Shuguang

Vice President, School of Economics, Ocean University of China

Prof. Liu is the PhD tutor and deputy director of Institute of Marine Development, and a visiting senior fellow at the S. Rajaratnam School of International Studies (RSIS) and Nanyang Technological University, Singapore. His major research interests are regional economics, world regional economic integration and marine economics. He was in charge of projects entrusted by UNDP, UNIDO, CCICED, National Science Foundation, National Soft Science, China Academy of Social Science and State Oceanic Administration etc.



Guo Wanda

Executive Vice President, China Development Institute

Dr. Guo received his PhD in economics from Nankai University, China. He is the Chairman of Shenzhen Association of Management Consultants, and consultant of the Policy-making Committee of Shenzhen Municipality. He specializes in the fields of China's macroeconomic and industrial policy studies. In recent years, he has been focusing on China's opening-up policy and the development of China's Special Economic Zones and the economic relationship between Hong Kong and Shenzhen. Low Carbon Economy is also one of his research concerns.

Zheng Yongnian

Director, the East Asian Institute, National University of Singapore
Prof. Zheng received his PhD in political science from Princeton University. He has studied both China's transformation and its external relations. He is Editor of Series on Contemporary China and Editor of China Policy Series. He served as a consultant to United Nation Development Programme. His papers have appeared in journals such as Comparative Political Studies, Political Science Quarterly, Third World Quarterly and China Quarterly. He is the author of 13 books.



Nguyen Anh Duong

Deputy Director, Department for Macroeconomic Policy and Integration Studies, Central Institute for Economic Management, Vietnam

Mr. Duong is member of Task Force of Vietnam Ministry of Planning and Investment on 'Macroeconomic Analysis and Forecast'; Task Force of Restructuring Vietnam's Economy till 2020; Task Force of Industrialization Strategy in Cooperation with Japan till 2020. He is now leading the projects on "Assessing Impacts of Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership on Vietnam's Economy", and "Assessing the Preparedness of Vietnam ahead of the ASEAN Economic Community in 2015".



Ng Yeen Seen

Senior Vice President / Chief Strategy & Programme Officer, Asia Strategy and Leadership Institute, Malaysia

Ms. Ng is a public intellectual and a young thought leader. She is also the Senior Director of Centre for Public Policy Studies and Senior Programme Director of the World Chinese Economic Forum and was Head of Secretariat of the Malaysia-China Business Council. She holds a postgraduate degree in Education Policy from Warwick University, UK. She is a frequent commentator of politics, education, economy and youth empowerment in national newspapers and often appears on various TV programmes.



Tan Sri Rastam Mohd Isa

Chief Executive, Institute of Strategic and International Studies, Malaysia

Tan Sri Rastam spent more than 36 years as a career diplomat in the service of the Government of Malaysia. He served in various capacities at the Ministry and Malaysian diplomatic missions abroad, including as Ambassador to Bosnia Herzegovina, Ambassador to the Republic of Indonesia and Permanent Representative to the United Nations etc. Throughout his career at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs he participated in numerous bilateral, regional and international meetings at ministerial and senior officials' levels.



Danilo Israel

Senior Research Fellow, Philippine Institute for Development Study

Dr. Israel got his PhD in natural resource economics and post-doctoral fellowship in natural resource and environmental economics. His research areas cover environmental valuation and policy, environmental impacts of macroeconomic policies, integrated coastal zone management, etc. He participated in numerous projects such as Batangas Bay Demonstration Project (UNDP), Mekong Valuation Project, etc. He had more than 90 publications, mostly in the fields of fisheries and aquatic resources economics and policy.



Wisarn Pupphavesa

Senior Advisor, Research Director, International Economic Relations, Thailand Development Research Institute

Dr. Pupphavesa received a PhD (Economics) from the University of Hawaii. He was Economist at Asian Development Bank and Consultant to ASEAN-MTN Project at UN-ESCAP. He was Member of the Council of Economic Advisors to the Prime Minister, Member of the International Economic Policy Committee, Member (Thailand's Representative) of the High Level Task Force on ASEAN-CER FTA. He has contributed nearly one hundred academic and policy research papers in the field of international and development economics.
